Brookley Road "Village Square" development

Delay in development. Unfortunately, there is existing unwanted pooling of water at the site. It is essential that both this pooling and any potential flooding issues in poor weather are resolved without creating further problems in the future. The design process has taken longer than anticipated and further surveys may be necessary. Consequently, a construction period cannot be provided at this time. As soon as further information is to hand timescales will be publicized.



Brockenhurst Flood Action Group has been allowed to join the New Forest National Park Consultative Panel. This will allow the Group to pass on what they have learnt from last year's flooding and drought not only to the Environment Agency and Forestry England but also Natural England and the National Park Authority. This is an important step towards involvement in the Natural Flood Management Project on the Weirs tributary, the Parish Council having secured representation, through the local Quadrant of Parish Councils, to the Freshwater and Wetlands Restoration Forum

Help to protect rare birds in the New Forest

The New Forest is one of the few places in the UK where rare ground nesting birds, such as the lapwing, nightjar and curlew come to breed. Unlike most birds, ground nesting birds build nests on the forest floor rather than in a tree or bush.

When out and about, you may notice Forestry England signs which have been put up around key nesting areas. To protect the birds from disturbance, please:

- stick to the main tracks
- *don't walk over open heathland areas where birds could be nesting*
- *keep dogs close to you, and where necessary use a lead*
